Introduction

With the recent transition from SNIC to NAISS there is an uncertainty as to how the need for user support for HPC users in Sweden will be met. It is anticipated that the new organisation with branches will be formed early in the fall of 2023. Thus, it is of interest to discuss at a high level what needs are to be met, how the organisation for exchange of competences can be arranged, and what the needs and capabilities of the HEI:s are.
